MAY NDIS UPDATE



PLAN REVIEWS & PREPARATION:

As we approach mid-year, many NDIS plans are coming up for review. Preparing early can make a big difference in ensuring your child continues to receive the right supports.

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO NOW?

Planning will be based on a support needs assessment, which may include:

- ✦ A conversation about your needs
- ✦ A short questionnaire
- ✦ Additional assessments if needed

WHAT THIS MEANS?

- ✦ Less time on reports = more time for supports
- ✦ More flexible budgets
- ✦ Plans better suited to real-life needs

Changes are expected from mid-2026, with a gradual rollout.

BENEFITS OF MSC WHEN HAVING A PLAN REVIEW

- ✦ **MSC LIAISING DIRECTLY WITH PROVIDERS**
MSC liaises with providers approximately 3 months before the participant's End of Plan date to request progress reports and supporting documentation.
- ✦ **FOLLOW UP & REVIEW INFORMATION**
MSC provides report due dates, follows up with providers as required, and reviews all received documentation to identify progress, ongoing needs, and support recommendations.
- ✦ **COMPLETE AND SUBMIT PLAN REVIEW DOCUMENTATION**
MSC completes the NDIS Support Coordination End of Plan Progress Report and submits all supporting documentation to the NDIS approximately 16 weeks prior to the End of Plan date to allow sufficient time for review and processing.
- ✦ **SUPPORT THE FAMILY THROUGHOUT THE PROCESS**
MSC keeps the family informed throughout the plan review process and provides support to ensure they are prepared for the review meeting and next plan period.
